Please note the following very important information:

1. **St Michael's is a fee-paying school.**
2. Fees must be paid quarterly in advance, unless alternative arrangements have been made with the bursar.
3. We pride ourselves in providing quality education in a caring environment. In order to maintain our high standards, we rely on all parents to pay their school fees promptly and in full.
4. School fees account for 61% of the budget of the school, whilst the contribution of the Department of Education accounts for only 29% of the needs of the school.
5. Every parent who does not honour his or her commitment to paying school fees, places at risk the maintenance of this school's unique ethos and character by threatening the continuation of the employment of additional teachers; sports coaches, ground staff, garden services, cleaning services, hostel supervisory staff – people who contribute to making St Michael's the special school it is.
6. Should your financial situation change during the course of the year, please contact the bursar as soon as possible.
7. According to the Government Gazette No 29311 dd 19 October 2006; General Notice of 2006 from the Department of Education, South African Schools Act No 84 of 1995; Regulations relating to the exemption of parents from payment of school fees in public schools, provision is made for parents in exceptional circumstances to apply for a partial or full exemption from the payment of school fees. Full details and a copy of the relevant legislation are available from the bursar on request. A copy of the legislation is also displayed in the bursar's office. Parents who need assistance in completing the necessary forms should request assistance from the bursar and / or the principal. The applicant is required to submit separate applications annually for each child for whom exemption is being sought. The applicant must provide the required documentation to support the application including, but not limited to (1) the combined annual gross income; (2) money received from investment; (3) profit gained from any form of business; (4) school fees for the applicant's child at the school; (5) additional monetary contributions paid by a parent in relation to a learner's attendance of, or participation in any programme of, a public school; (6) any other additional relevant information.
